2. Urges for the help of the World Bank to fund the research of a supercomputer to host the A.I.
3. Requests that the Supercomputer and the AI be
  - a. Supervised under NGO's
  - b. Kept in an unspecified location unknown by member countries of the UN
  - c. Installed with a self destruct mechanizm in the case that is falls in the wrong hands which could be the end of the internet as we know it.
4. Denies North Korea any role in the designing/funding/building of the Supercomputer or the A.I for they are a hostile nation known for their cyber attacks over the world.

5. Insists on humane punishments to be dealt on offenders such as but not limited to

*Human Rights Council,*

  - c. by making public spots by using TV commercials.

  - a. by creating tools or programs for blocking hackers.
